### ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES:

- 1) Event started with food and drinks.
- 2) Welcome and introductions were provided by President Hunt McKinnon.
- 3) Carolyn Farley with Dirt Environmental Solutions then provided a Continuing Education presentation called "Build for Better Education." The course explored how manufactured interior construction (pre-fab interiors) solutions provide opportunities for faster project delivery and cost savings, as well as flexibility of layout and use. The presented systems also allow for future adaptability with changing technology and plug and play access for electronics. CE Credit = 1 HSW
- 4) The CE course was followed by more fellowship (food and drinks) and presentations from staff.
- 5) Hunt introduced our Eastern Section Scholarship winner who was in attendance, Katie O'Campo.
- 6) Treasurer Tripp Eure presented the 2017 Financial Report.
  - a. The Eastern Section funded two \$1,500 Scholarships to selected students attending the NC State University School of Architecture and the University of North Carolina at Charlotte School of Architecture.
  - b. Tripp reported that the Eastern Section also established and paid for a \$10,000 Eastern Section iPAL and ARE Scholarship Fund and a \$10,000 AIA Eastern Section Scholarship fund for students at NCSU and UNC Charlotte (\$20,000 to each institution for a total \$40,000).
  - c. Budget for 2018 was presented and a motion was made to approve of the 2017 Report as well as the 2018 budget, was seconded and was approved by all.
- 7) Election of Officers: The following Candidates for 2018 Eastern Section were presented, were uncontested and therefore were elected by acclamation.
  - a. 2017 Board to be as follows:

- 8) Elections were followed by a presentation of the Eastern Section's Activate NC Hurricane House designs.
  - a. In attendance were students from the East Carolina University Interior Design program that assisted the Eastern Section AIA in the design and drawing of the Activate NC Hurricane Houses.
  - b. The houses are intended to serve as a book of affordable, small house plan solutions for victims of hurricanes and flood event. The houses range in size from 800 to 1,200 sq. ft.
- 9) Hunt also presented a recap of the Princeville, NC Community Development workshop attended by Eastern Section officers in August. The workshop was put on to explore development ideas for infrastructure, housing, public facilities, businesses, and community open space on a 52-acre parcel of land slated to be annexed by the Town of Princeville. The charrette looked at how the parcel can be physically, socially, environmentally and economically connected to the existing Town of Princeville and other parcels of land adjacent to the Town that have yet to be acquired and at the same time flood resilient.
- 10) Meeting was closed and guests were invited to mingle and socialize.
